

# Cox's Bazar, Bangladesh: Child Protection Sub-Sector Achievements (as of 6 Nov 2017)

Since the renewed influx from Myanmar in August 2017, there has been an increase in the number of Rohingya refugee girls and boys in Cox's Bazar Division, with an estimated 450,000\* children across 126 sites as of October. Six Child Protection implementing partners have reached more than 64,850 girls and boys with services, including psychosocial support, life skills and resilience programming, among others.
